- Discussed the State Competition Registration Packet. Curtis Kaloi addressed several topics/issues to be changed, deleted or modified before it is to be sent out. Also discussed the staging areas, event descriptions, and made some appropriate changes.
- Discussed the TLEEAA Scholarship awards be set at a minimum of \$500 dollars. Requirements to include a 1,000 word essay and two letters of recommendation.
